- 2) Once you so this you will arrive at the "Log On" page. This page can be identified with a picture of 4 officials on the left side of the screen (under the OHSAA logo).
- 3) Unless you are already an OHSAA licensed official in another sport, click on "register". (highlighted in orange) This will take you to the **DASHBOARD**.
